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History



Belarusian State University of Physical Culture has a rich history. The University, one of the oldest sporting institutions in the world, was established in 1929. It was the long way from the technical school till acknowledged university. Initially Belarusian State Technical School of Physical Culture was renamed many times. In 1937 it was reorganized and renamed into Belarusian State Institute of Physical Culture and acquired the status of higher education institution. The first group of students graduated from the University in 1939.

During the Second World War the University was forced to interrupt the educational process, but immediately, after the liberation of Belarus, BSUPC reactivated its activity and in 1946 postwar graduation took place.





In 1965 the postgraduate study was set up. Since then applicants for a degree of candidate of educational science started to study. In 1992 the University was reformed to the Academy of Physical Culture. It became possible thanks to University's graduates and their achievements in sport. The same year the Institution of Doctoral Candidacy was established. In 2003 the Academy was renamed into Belarusian State University of Physical Culture.

The University passed a long way of development. During that time, a lot of Olympic, world and Europe champions were trained at our University. Large amount of scientific conferences, symposiums and seminars were held, and new specialities were developed.





Science

Belarusian State University of Physical Culture is the major scientific center in the sphere of physical culture, sport and tourism in our country. Masters program, postgraduate program, doctoral program, Dissertation Council, Interdepartmental academic and research laboratory are acting in our University.

Master's program at BSUPC enables to get professional development in such spheres as:

Theory and methodology of physical education, sports training, health-improving and adaptive physical culture;

Management of innovative projects in the tourist industry;

Innovative management in the sphere of tourism;

Innovative management in the sphere of hospitality;

Innovative technologies in the sphere of tourism and hospitality.

Postgraduate program conducts training in such specialities as Theory and methodology of physical education, sports training, health-improving and adaptive physical culture and physiology.

Doctoral program sspeciality is Theory and methodology of physical education, sports training, health-improving and adaptive physical culture.

Interdepartmental academic and research laboratory works successfully for the provision of sports specialists with up-to-date scientific and methodological information.

The University cooperates with related departments of other educational institutions of the Republic of Belarus and develops relationship with leading sports universities of Russia, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Armenia, Poland, Moldova, Bulgaria, Latvia, Lithuania, Germany, China, etc. University's lecturers visit foreign countries for participation in international sport conferences, professional development, internships, studying of professional experience, development of educational courses and programs. Our students and post-graduate students were awarded at the international scientific contests many times. The University holds seminars and conferences annually for active experience exchange between specialists in the sphere of physical culture, sport and tourism.





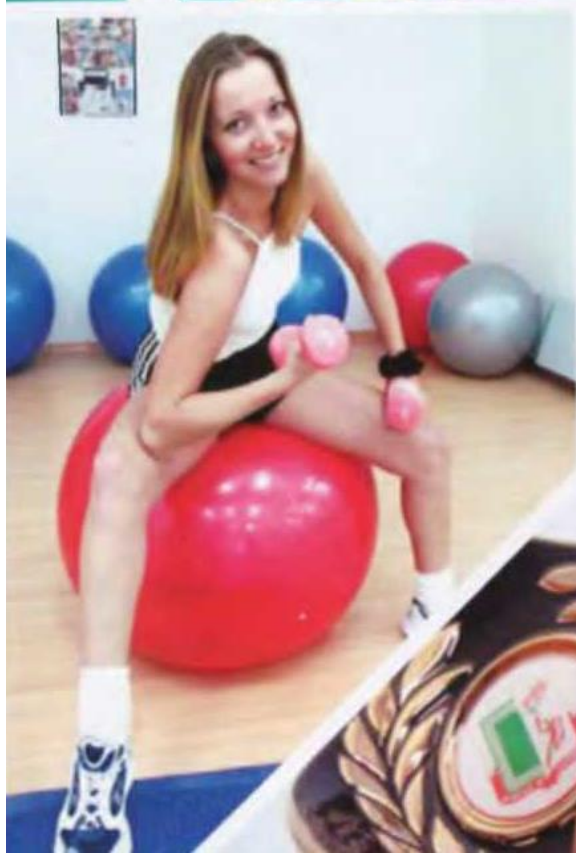
Faculty of Pre-University Preparation

The faculty was established in 1996 with the main goal to teach foreign students the Russian language and to prepare University entrants for exams. The faculty disposes a various range of courses. Besides, the each University entrant can choose the courses that he/she wants to study. It is also possible to choose long-term or short-term schedule on the base of evening/day class.

The foreigners training foundation to enter the higher education institutions is studying of Russian language. At Russian language lessons foreign students improve their skills in grammar and phonetics, study Russian and Belarusian literature, as well as familiarize with culture and traditions of Slavic nations. Moreover, foreign students study biology, geography, mathematics, physical training and other subjects according to their personal choice. Classes are conducted by teachers of the faculty who have extensive experience in preparing students for entering to the higher education institutions of the Republic of Belarus.

The profitable result of teaching staff's work is the high readiness of the faculty graduates to enter the University and study successfully.





Faculty of Health-Improving Physical Culture and Tourism

The faculty was established in 1990 on the basis of Pedagogical Faculty. The main aim of the faculty is to train specialists for the people's recovering with the help of physical culture and sport. The faculty gives much consideration to sports aspect. Wushu and billiards are the leading sports of the faculty.

There are 10 departments at the faculty: 4 theoretical departments and 6 graduating departments. It gives the opportunity to gain specialty in sports management, tourism management, sports and recreational tourism, ergotherapy, adaptive, improving, medicinal physical culture, physical rehabilitation, etc.

Many students combine their studies with occupational work. First of all students enrich their practical experience. Also, they provide feasible assistance to different organizations in the field of people's health improvement by means of physical culture.

The faculty is in favor among applicants every year. Students of the faculty take up top positions in the Annual University Academic Progress Report. The academic staff and the administration of the faculty try to be up-to-date and do their best to modernize studying programs and develop new fields of training.

Graduates of the faculty successfully work at Ministry of Sport and Tourism of the Republic of Belarus and in its network, in different educational institutions and health-improving centers, clinics, travel companies, where they consolidate the high image of the Faculty of Health-Improving Physical Culture and Tourism.





Faculty of Sport Games and Combative Sports

The faculty was established in 1972. The foundation of the faculty was the reaction on growing demand of qualified trainers. Our country has scored a great success in sport and sorely requires further progress. The main goal of the Faculty of Sport Games and Combative Sports was the highly qualified training for the stable development of Belarusian sport.

The faculty includes 8 departments: 5 graduating and 3 theoretical. Departments specialize in such sports as bicycling, speed skating, equestrian sport, basketball, volleyball, handball, tennis, Greco-Roman style, free-style wrestling, unarmed self-defence, judo, fencing, box, football, hockey, figure skating, weightlifting, etc.

Students get diversified and versatile education. It gives them broad employment opportunities to work as trainers, teachers of physical culture, organizers and officials in the sphere of physical culture and sport.

The faculty is proud of famous alumni such as Triple Olympic Champion A.Medved (wrestling), World, Europe and Olympic Champions O.Karavaev, V.Zubkov (wrestling), V.Kaminski, O.Logvin (bicycling), I.Zhelezovski (speed skating), A.Nikanchikov, V.Sidyak, A.Romankov (fencing), I.Edeshko, G.Savitskaya, T.Beloshapko, I.Sumnikova (basketball), K.Sharovarov, G.Sviridenko, M.Yakimovich, A.Minevski, Y.Shevtsov (handball), etc.





Faculty of Mass Sports

The faculty was established in 1973 on the basis of Sport Faculty opened in 1959. The faculty of Mass Sports was reorganized and renamed many times in subsequent years: through the whole period of time it was called: pedagogical and teachers'. But in spite of that, the faculty has a wide history and in the centre of it's attention was always the sport.

9 departments are included in the structure of the faculty: 7 graduating and 2 theoretical. There are such dominating sports as gymnastics, acrobatics, mountaineering, aerobics, sports dances, track and field athletics, swimming, hand-to-hand fight, karate, taekwondo, cross country skiing, shooting, orienteering, biathlon, rowing, motoring at the faculty.

Many-sided and multifunctional education gives the opportunity to work successfully as trainers, teachers of physical culture, organizers and officials in the sphere of physical culture and sport. Also, a lot of graduating students join to work at University as a part of academic staff. The Faculty of Mass Sports is justifiably proud of its students' and graduates' achievements. There are numerous Olympic, Europe, World champions and prize winners, successful researchers among our graduates.

The faculty always moves forward and studies the labour-market to help graduating students to settle in concrete sports sphere. The motto of the faculty is the building of successful sports future on the stable Olympic base.





Institute of Tourism

Institute of Tourism was established in 2004, but in spite of its young age, the Institute occupied leading positions in the sphere of tourism and hospitality in Belarus. The Institute realizes training, retraining, study course and professional development of specialists in the field of tourism, hospitality, recreation and excursion. There is a great accent to tourism in Belarus, that's why the Institute of Tourism tries not to keep pace with the time and offers modern techniques of studying, teaching, modern resource base: visual and print aids, video materials, well-developed infrastructure. Also, graduates of the Institute are in high demand both in our country and abroad.

Institute of Tourism consists of two faculties: the Faculty of Tourism and Hospitality and the Faculty of Professional Development and Retraining. So, the Institute gives an opportunity to start the educational process from the beginning or to raise the professional development. Institute of Professional Development and Retraining

The Institute of Professional Development and Retraining was established in 2000 on the base of Faculty of Professional Development of the Academy of Physical Culture.

There are two faculties functioning in the structure of the Institute: the Faculty of Professional Development and the Faculty of Retraining. The teachers of physical culture from specialized secondary schools and universities are trained at the Institute. Institute fulfills the training of professionals on the following specialities: sports and health improvement activity in education establishments, preschool physical education, health-improving physical training, coaching and management of sports organizations, sports law.

Every year more than 2500 specialists raise their professional development and about 150 specialists go off their retraining at the Institute. The most important directions of the Institute's activity is the extension and perfection of methodological base, the rendering of analytical and informational help to sports foundings and functionaries.

Alma Mater is Proud of! Famous Alumni

Belarusian State University of Physical Culture is famous not only for academic activities, but also for great, successful graduating students, who glorify our University and Belarus. BSUPC brings up numerous Olympic, World and Europe Champions and prize winners, among them Svetlana Boginskaya, Vitaly Scherbo, Marina Lobatch, Aleksandr Medved, Ellina Zvereva, Yanina Karolchyk-Pravalinskaya, Vladimir Parfenovich, Ekaterina Karsten. All these people made marvelous contribution in the development of world sport.

Aleksandr Medved is a famous Soviet/Belarusian wrestler. He is considered by most to be the best freestyle wrestler of all the time. He was the first person ever to win three gold medals in freestyle wrestling. His non-Olympic awards include: World championships: 7 times (1962-63, 1966-67, 1969-71), European championships: 3 times (1966, 1968, 1972). FILA recognizes Medvedev as The Greatest Wrestler of the 20th Century in Freestyle. He was the flag-bearer for the Belarusian Olympic team on several occasions including the 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens. He also performed the Judge's Oath at the 1980 Summer Olympics. Also Alexander Medved is the Olympic coach of the Belarusian freestyle wrestling team. What is more Medved is not only a famous sportsman but a successful writer also, he has written two books about his sport career, which are well-known around the world.





Vladimir Parfenovich is a famous Belarusian sprint canoer and graduated student of Belarusian State University of Physical Culture, who competed from the late 1970s to the early 1980s. He is the only sprint canoer in the world who won three Olympic gold medals at the same Olympic Games; he achieved this at 1980 Summer Olympics in Moscow, winning golds in the K-1 500 m, K-2 500 m, and K-2 1000 m events. Parfenovich also won thirteen medals at the ICF Canoe Sprint World Championships with ten golds (K-1 500 m: 1979, 1981, 1982, 1983; K-2 500 m: 1979, 1981, 1982; K-2 1000 m: 1979, 1981, 1982) and three silvers (K-1 500 m: 1978, K-2 500 m: 1983, K-2 1000 m: 1983).

Elena Belova is a famous Belarusian fencer. Honored master of sports, Olympic Champion, World Champion and Europe Champion in the individual competition and team competition. The list of her personal awards and prizes just strikes: Helen is a four-time Olympic Champion and eight time World Champion. She won Olympic gold in Mexico in 1968 in the individual competition and team competition, in Munich in 1972 and in Montreal in 1976 in the team competition. She gained a silver medal at the Games in Moscow in 1980 in the team competition, bronze medal in Montreal in 1976 in the individual championship and the list of her awards is endless. Helen is a unique woman, who is not only a successful athlete, but also a prominent social and political activist, she is the representative of Belarus at the association "European Women and Sport".

Ellina Zvereva is a renowned Belarusian discus thrower, best known for winning the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics. Also Ellina was the participant of numerous Europe and World championships and became world champion in 1995, and again in 2001. Her personal best is 71.58 m. Ellina started her Olympic way in 1988 in Seoul, South Korea and since then she was the participant of 5 Olympics.

Ekaterina Karsten is a famous Belarusian rower, an Olympic Champion and World Champion in single sculls. The list of her personal awards and prizes is endless: Katerina is a two-times Olympic Champion and six times World Champion. She won Olympic gold in single sculls in 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta and 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney. In 2004 Summer Olympics in Athens she won a silver medal and in 2008 she picked up a bronze. She has also won the World championships in single sculls in 1997, 1999, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2009, was runner up in 2002, 2010 and got bronze in 2001 and 2003. Katerina is one of the most prolific athletes all over the world.

Vitaly Scherbo – famous Soviet and Belarusian gymnast, a six-time Olympic Champion in 1992 (the only non-swimmer in history who won six gold medals at one games). One of the best gymnasts of all time (the only man who became World Champion in all 8 disciplines: individual and team competitions and also, at 6 shells). Honored Master of Sport of the USSR (1991), Honored Master of Sport of the Republic of Belarus (1994).

Yanina Karolchyk – Belarusian shot putter. Honored Master of Sport of the Republic of Belarus. Olympic and World Champion.





Victoria Azarenka is a four-time winner of the Grand Slam tournaments, six-time runner-up of the Grand Slam tournaments (2 – singles, 3 – doubles, 1 – mixed doubles). She won gold medal in the mixed doubles at the 2012 Summer Olympics in London. Azarenka is a two-time winner of the junior Grand Slam tournaments in the singles (Australian Open, US Open-2005) and four-time winner of the junior Grand Slam tournaments in the doubles. She is runner-up of the Orange Bowl-20 in the doubles.

Aleksandra Gerasimenya is two-time Vice-Champion of the 2012 Olympic Games (50 and 100 m in freestyle), winner of the European and World championships at the "short" (25 meter pool) and "long (50 meter pool) course". Also, she is a multiple champion of the World Student's Games (2009, 2011 and 2013) and Honored Master of Sports of the Republic of Belarus (2012).

Aleksandr and Andrey Bogdanovich are glorious representatives of sport virtue, devotion and team spirit. They are Olympic Champions 2008 and Olympic silver medalists 2012.

Lubov Cherkashina won individual bronze medal at the 2012 Olympic Games. She is a multiple European and World gymnastics rhythmic prizewinner and Honored Master of Sports of the Republic of Belarus (2011).

Anton Kushnir is champion of the 2014 Winter Olympics in Sochi. Also, he is a winner of Freestyle Skiing World Cup 2009/2010, European Cup 2004, silver medalist of the World Cup overall ranking 2007/2008.

International Cooperation

Highly Developed Infrastructure

BSUPC can boast of large-scale opportunities for successful learning process: sports and educational buildings with numerous gyms and cosy lecture halls, football stadium, dormitory, track and field hall, swimming pool, plate constructions, scientific library, which holds candidate and doctoral dissertations, periodicals and research papers which were created not only in Belarus but abroad. What is more, the University's infrastructure and teaching methodology is modernizing all the time with the help of universities-partners. It gives an opportunity to realize successful educational, training, scientific and research processes.

Moreover, our students have a great opportunity to gain additional education, to enrich their knowledge and expand their horizons with the help of various seminars, trainings, elective courses, sports groups, tourist services. There are numerous optional classes in BSUPC: courses of foreign languages, massage courses, etc. Also BSUPC can offer lots of sports groups for everyone, training and testing programs.





In detail about courses, trainings and programs: there are following courses that you can find at the University: massage, shaping, aerobics, bodybuilding, pilates, sports aerobics, aquaerobics, fitness, tennis, biomechanical stimulation, the basics of computer work, trainings of executives for security services, applied industrial climbing, psychology.

Trainings: healthy lifestyle and self-development, psychological preparation of athletes and coaches, integrative psychotechnology.

Tourist center: excursions, day-off tours.

Sports groups: boxing, fencing, fitness fencing, sports aerobics, artistic and rhythmic gymnastics, acrobatics, wushu, ballroom and sports dance, rock'n'roll, break dance, age-related aerobics, shooting gallery, billiards, hand-to-hand fighting, karate, taekwondo, unarmed self-defence, wrestling, school of body posture correction.

Testing: modern non-drug means of health improvement, testing of physical efficiency, consultations of nutrition, elaboration of individual weight loss and correction of figure programs, determination of fat mass component.



Students' Life

The University pays much attention to students' self-expression. Socially and civic minded students have favourable conditions for the realization of personal potential, the development of students' autonomy and support of their initiatives.

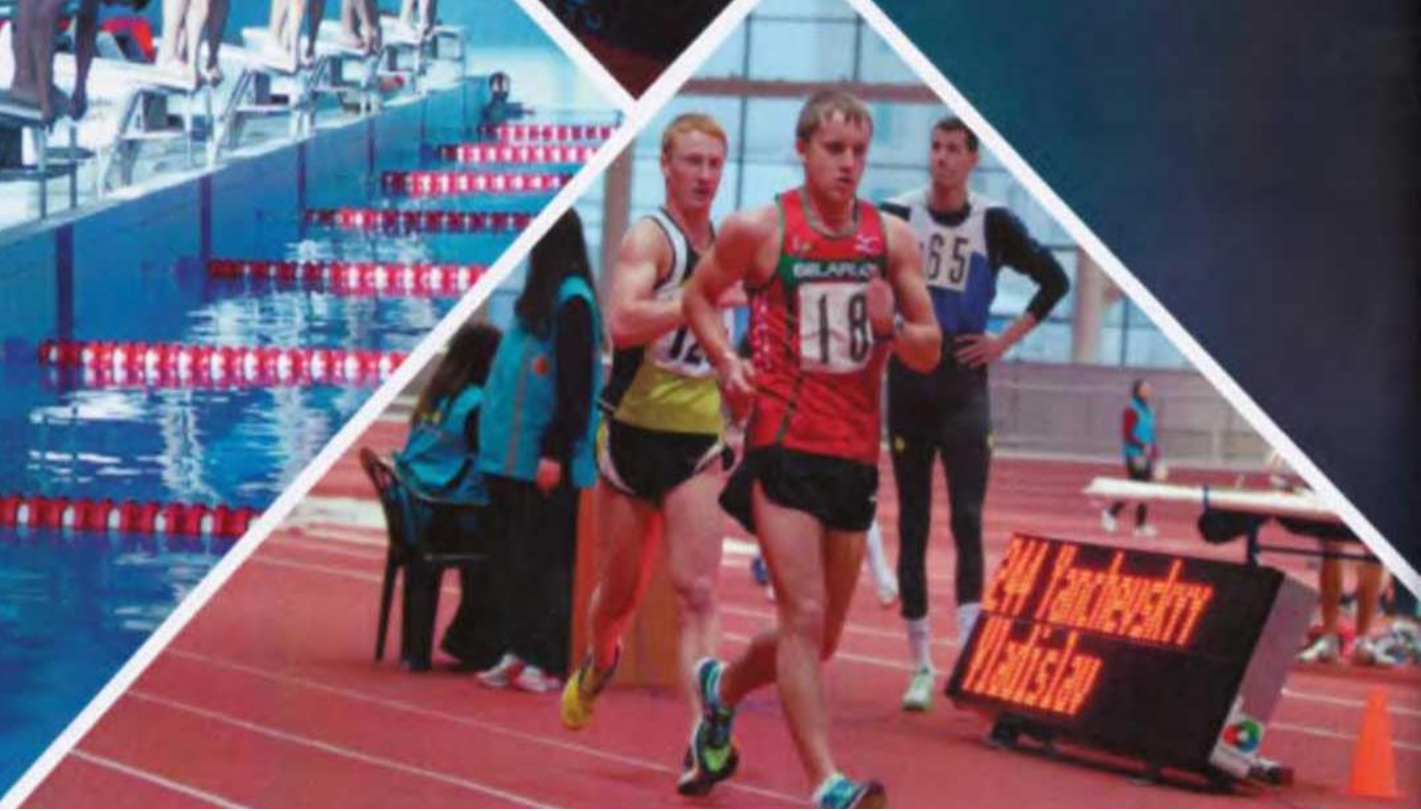

Sports Life

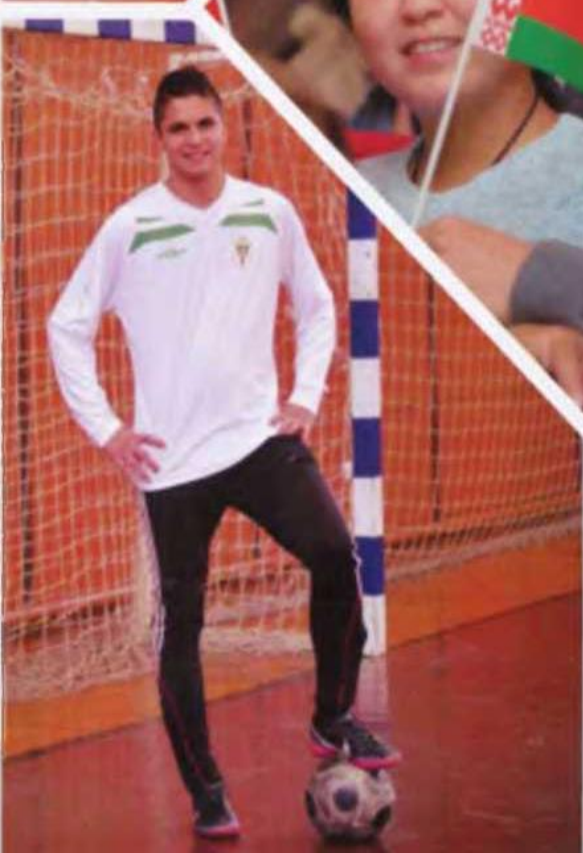
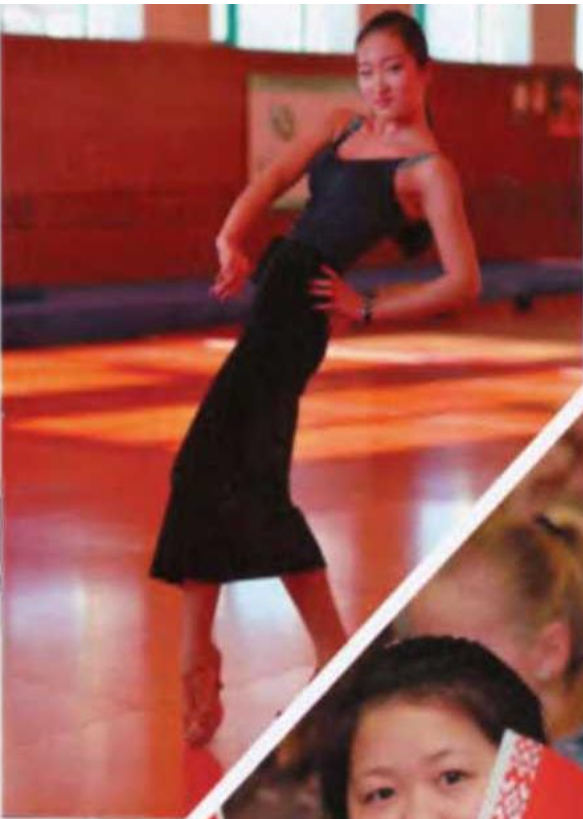
Sport is a fundamental element in the university philosophy. The University pays enormous attention to the development of this sphere. BSUPC can be proud of famous graduates: A.Medved, E.Belova, V.Sidyak, M.Lobach, E.Karsten, Y.Karolchyk-Pravalinskaya, D.Daschinski, N.Tsylinskaya, A.Gerasimenya, I.Zhukov, V.Gurkov, A.Lazutkin, V.Volchkov, A. Kushnir, V. Azarenko etc. During the whole university's history students and graduates have been representing our country with dignity and honor at the competitions of the highest level. Their awards are the result of hard diligent work of the University's collective.

Various sports seminars, where the most outstanding sportsmen take part in, are held at our University. Also, a lot of trainings are carried out in cooperation with universities-partners. The University gives an opportunity to take part in this events for everyone. All arrangements are designed to diversify, motivate and make the learning process more interesting.

Foreign Students

Belarusian State University of Physical Culture pays special attention to the foreign students' education. Our University does the best to integrate foreign students in Belarusian living environment and culture surroundings, to create comfort conditions for studies, leisure and sports activities. The University extended the deadline for the foreigners' entrance applications (till the 15th of October at faculties, till the 1st of November at Faculty of Pre-University Preparation). The number of Russian language lessons was increased, and what is more, BSUPC provides foreign students the opportunity to handle the favourite sports. Foreigners are also involved in recreational activities such as relax skating, or hiking.

If foreign applicants want to enter BSUPC, they need to present to the International Department the following documents, as well as to get studying invitation (for countries where visa is needed):

1. The passport and its notarised translation into Russian (if it is not in Russian).
2. The certificate of education with supplements of the studied subjects and the marks given and their notarised translations into Russian (if it is not in Russian).
3. The medical certificate and its notarised translation into Russian (if it is not in Russian).
4. HIV-test certificate and its notarised translation into Russian (if it is not in Russian).
5. The birth certificate/copy of the birth certificate and its notarised translation into Russian (if it is not in Russian).
6. Pre-University Preparation certificate or the Preparatory Department certificate (if you don't have it you will have the examination in Russian language at BSUPC).



To take invitation foreign applicant should sent the copies of these documents via E-mail, mail or fax.

Requirements to the applicants:

1. Sufficient level of the previous education.

2. Enough level of the Russian language:

a) successful graduation from the Faculty of Pre-University Preparation (learning of Russian as a foreign language);

b) satisfactory interview results which establish the level of the Russian language necessary for the studying process in the amount for obtaining BSUPC curriculum.

3. Besides the interview, foreign applicants, who want to study at Faculty of Health-Improving Physical Culture and Tourism, Faculty of Sport Games and Combative Sports or Faculty of Mass Sports, should pass the examination in general physical preparedness in chosen sports.

4. All applicants must get a medical certificate about the health condition issued by the healthcare institution of Belarus (after arriving).
